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 Q: *German words always have a u after the q making a distinct k-v sound*

Y: *Very few German words begin with y*

ä *sounds similar to the e in melon* z.B. *ähnlich*

ö *sounds similar to the l in girl* z.B. *zwölf*

ü *no approx sound in English* z.B. *müde*

ß *double ss* z.B. *heiß*
